

## Idaho nonprofits receive Allen foundation grants

The Paul G. Allen Family Foundation has awarded \$11.8 million in grants to 77 nonprofit organizations in the Pacific Northwest — three of them in Idaho.

The Idaho recipients are the Boise Art Museum, with a grant of \$150,000 over three years to support the 2008-2010 season exhibitions; Catholic Charities of Idaho with a grant of \$150,000 over three years for a capacity building project on program evaluation and accreditation, and the Company of Fools theater company in Hailey.

The group will receive a \$15,000 grant to support its production, "Fools Exposed 2008."

Paul G. Allen Family Foundation supports nonprofit organizations focused on making "positive and measurable change" in the Pacific Northwest with an emphasis on the arts, children's education, vulnerable populations and advancing science and technology.
