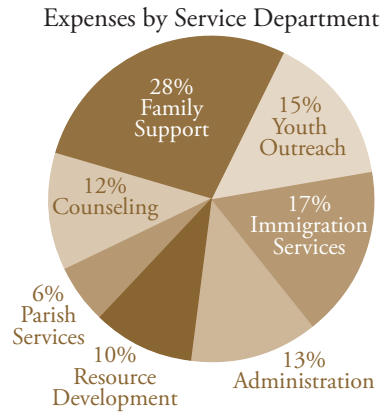
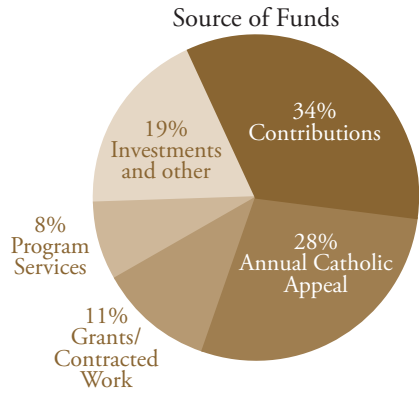

# Called to Serve

Dear Friends,

This past year we were called to serve in a manner that we never imagined. The lives of many families, individuals and children were changed as a result of Hurricanes Katrina and Rita. As thousands of evacuees were forced from their homes and left devastated by the loss of loved ones, Catholic Charities around the nation responded to the call providing support and comfort to those stricken by the unimaginable.

As a new agency having been established only 5 years ago, Catholic Charities of Idaho did not hesitate to answer the call. With the assistance of public agencies, corporate organizations and the Idaho community, we quickly established a Disaster Relief and Resettlement program. We received donations that assisted us in providing critical needs such as shelter, food, clothing, counseling, and case management services to 64 evacuees in 2005. However, our work is far from being done; we continue to provide supportive services to those evacuees who have resettled in Idaho, a place they now call home.

Additionally, this past year Catholic Charities experienced the retirement of its founding Executive Director, Dr. Marie Hoff. Under Dr. Hoff's direction, Catholic Charities of Idaho opened its doors in Boise in September 2001 and grew to ten service sites throughout the state. She leaves behind a legacy of passion and commitment towards social justice.

As we begin this new and exciting journey, we invite your participation and support. What we have begun can only grow. We welcome your help in our growth. May God bless you always.

### Invested in Future Idaho Leaders

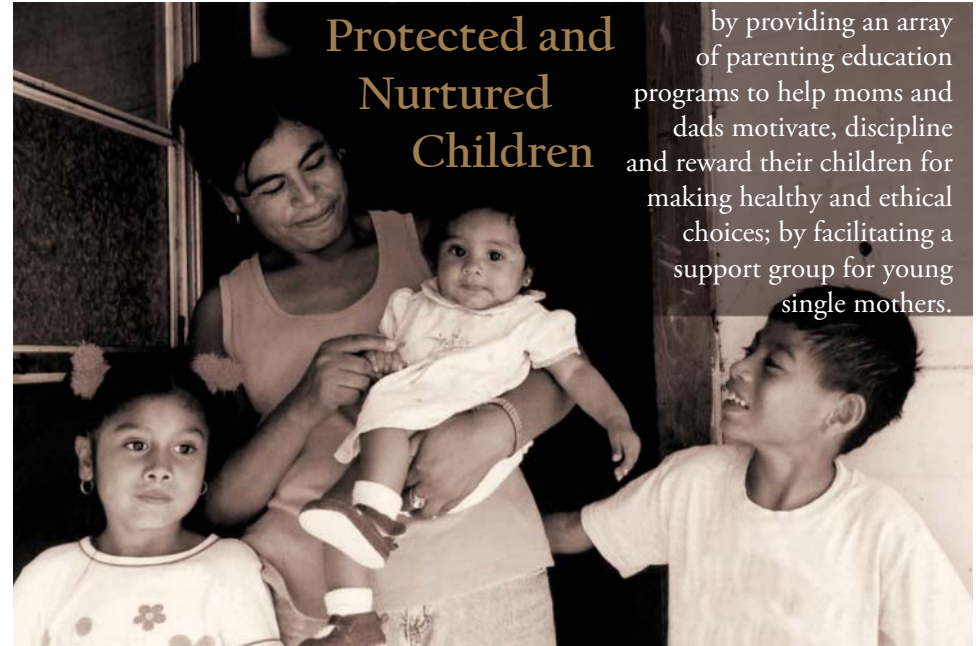

**Assisted Newcomers** through a variety of citizenship and immigration services with a special concern for family reunification and support for victims of domestic violence or human trafficking.



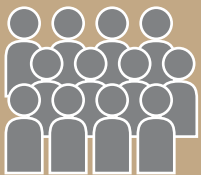

### Helped Idaho Cope

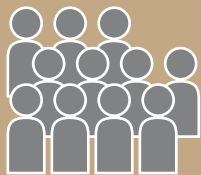

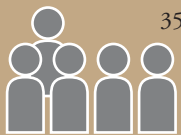
