

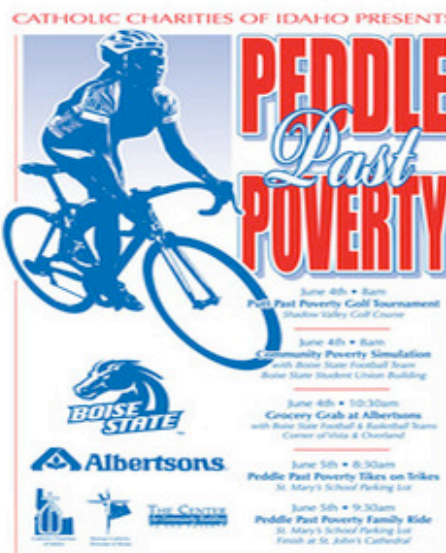


Peddle Past Poverty Newsletter June 2010

Currently, 62,000 Idahoans live below the poverty line. This means far too many families of four scraping to get by on less than \$1838.00 a month. Without adequate access to basic resources families experience much higher incidences of stress, domestic violence, and child abuse.
