The Christian Mental Health Counselor will provide out-patient counseling to individuals, children, couples, and families at Catholic Charities of Idaho. The counselor will work with a team of other counselors under the supervision of the Clinical Director. We are a diverse office, counseling individuals of all faiths and backgrounds, including children, adolescents, and adults. We are committed to serving our clients with a Christian understanding of the person, marriage, and family life, as well as each individual's culture, race, and religion.

At Catholic Charities Counseling Services, we seek to enable our clients to overcome emotional and/or behavioral obstacles that prevent them from realizing their full potential. Our staff members bring compassion and varied clinical experience to the services provided to our clients. We offer in-person counseling at our Boise office counseling center and other areas of the State via tele-health.

Client issues have included (but are not limited to) various mood and anxiety disorders, relationship concerns (including marriage and pre-marital), addiction issues (substance and process), trauma-related issues, problem behaviors, as well as matters related to adolescence and parenting.
